

**Deciding to undertake a train journey:**

- One service sector determines that the person has unmet or overprovided needs arising from a condition covered by another service sector.
- That sector engages with the other sector in order to address the unmet or overprovided needs.

**Packing your bags for the Journey:**

- Confirmation of all diagnoses.
- Severity, significance and prognoses established for all diagnoses.
- Needs assessments that adequately cover all conditions & types of need.
- This information shared with all involved sectors.

**The Departure Lounge – consulting the Departure Board:**

- Discussions between service coordinators.
- Agreement on diagnosis, significance and needs (i.e. disability profile).

The process then branches into five platforms, each leading to a line and a specific condition profile:

- Platform 1 (Red):** Line 1, >90%. A condition is the sole contributor to the person's need(s) for care.
- Platform 2 (Black):** Line 2, >65% / <35%. While this condition is the principal contributor to the person's need(s) for care, they also have ongoing needs relating to another condition.
- Platform 3 (Green):** Line 3, 40/60% → 60/40%. The person has 2 or more conditions, both/all of which make significant contributions to their needs for care.
- Platform 4 (Black):** Line 4, >65% / <35%. While the 2<sup>nd</sup> condition is the principal contributor to the person's need(s) for care, they also have ongoing needs relating to the 1<sup>st</sup> condition.
- Platform 5 (Blue):** Line 5, >90%. A condition is the sole contributor to the person's need(s) for care.

The process then moves through four stages:

- Departure point:** Initial condition assessment.
- Stop 1:** Responsibility for the person's supports is assigned.
- Stop 2:** Service options are determined.
- Stop 3 (End of journey):** Funding arrangements are finalized.

**Summary of Funding Arrangements:**

Platform 3	Line 3	40/60% → 60/40%: 2 or more conditions	Responsibility for the person's supports is shared between the service sectors covering the person's conditions.	Supports that are jointly developed and funded by both service sectors.	Co-funding with blended or mosaic funding by both service sectors.
Platform 4	Line 4	>65% / <35%: 2 <sup>nd</sup> condition is principal contributor	1° responsibility for the person's supports is taken by the 2 <sup>nd</sup> service sector, with 2° responsibility taken by the 1 <sup>st</sup> service sector.	Services for the 2 <sup>nd</sup> condition with access to contracts or discretionary funding through the 1 <sup>st</sup> service sector.	Co-funding with add-on funding by one sector or mosaic funding by both.
Platform 5	Line 5	>90%: Sole contributor	Sole responsibility for the person's supports being taken by the service sector that covers this condition.	Mainstream services for one condition alone.	Single source funding.
